Weekly Produce Share - 30 boxes - A seasonal selection of fresh, clean, organic produce delivered weekly, May 10 through October and every-other-week in November and December. Expect it to meet the needs of a household of 2 adults and 2 children. This is the most economical option per box, and our preference for simplicity. If a box every week is too much for you, try splitting or alternating weekly boxes with another small household.

Every - Other - Week Produce Share - 17 boxes - The same seasonal selection of clean, organic produce we pack in the weekly box, but delivered every-other-week, May - December. Meets the needs of small households who choose not to split a weekly share with another family. We are unable to change the dates of your delivery to accommodate vacations and special needs with the every-other-week share. If you would like this convenience, please sign up for the flex plan. E-O-W members pick up on EITHER "green" or "brown" weeks.*

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Extended Season - 2 boxes - An extension of the regular CSA box. Similar to December boxes but larger and with a special surprise. First box delivered January 10, 2009; second on January 24, 2009.

Coffee Share - 19 deliveries - An every-other-week delivery of one or two pounds of whole bean, certified organic, fair trade Kickapoo coffee. Coffee is freshly roasted the day before delivery. "Roasters choice" - coffee varieties rotate weekly, Harmony Valley Blend is the most frequently delivered roast. Coffee is delivered on "brown weeks", the opposite week as fruit, for 19 weeks.

Fruit Program - An every-other-week box of certified organic fruit, sourced at its peak from the best fruit growing regions of North America. Sixteen deliveries: ten from June 21 through October 25, six from November 8 through January 24. Fruit is delivered on "green weeks", the opposite week as coffee.
